### Stability and Storage

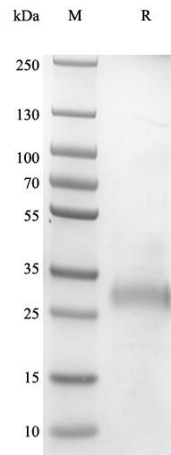
<b>Storage</b>	Store at -20 ~ -80°C, avoid repeated freeze/ thaw cycle
<b>Stability</b>	Aliquot and store at -20°C for 12 months.
<b>Constituents</b>	Lyophilized from 0.22 µm filtered solution in PBS, pH7.4.

### General information

<b>Function</b>	Important adipokine involved in the control of fat metabolism and insulin sensitivity. Stimulates AMPK phosphorylation and activation in the liver and the skeletal muscle. Antagonizes TNF-alpha by negatively regulating its expression in various tissues such as liver and macrophages, and also by counteracting its effects. Inhibits endothelial NF-kappa-B signaling through a cAMP-dependent pathway.
